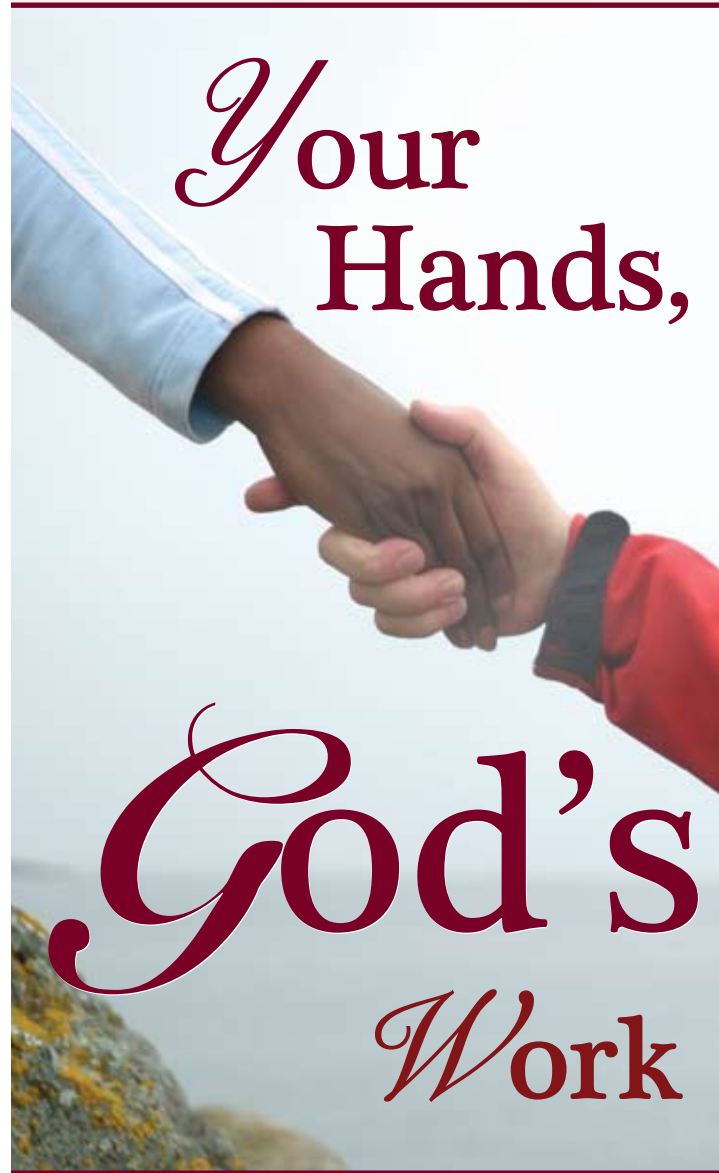

2009 Catholic Charity Fund Appeal

Your Annual Gift Impacts and Changes Lives in Our Community.

Your gift to the annual Appeal impacts the lives of 31,100 children and youth as well as 3,804 volunteer catechists and aides through the Office of Religious Education.



Because of you and your generosity, a total of 298 families were assisted with child care grants. The Cabrini Fund helps to pay part of the cost of licensed child care for working families who meet low to moderate income guidelines.



Your donation to the Catholic Charity Fund Appeal impacts the lives of over 1,646 children who attended the Mother of Hope Camp in Chepachet.



Through your support of the Catholic Charity Fund Appeal, 4,400 youth attended retreats from over 60 parishes and 12 schools.



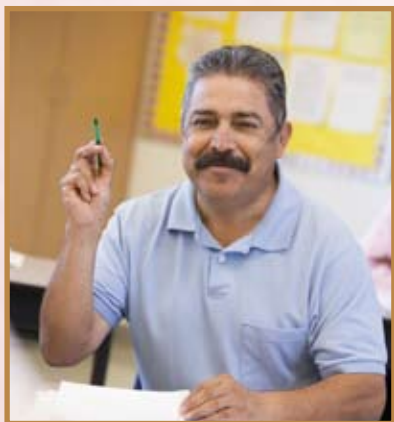
A total of 4,284 immigrants and 280 refugees are helped because of your generous gift to the annual Appeal.

At the Saint Martin de Porres Center in Providence, 7,942 elders and low-income families are served annually. In addition to the 900 hot meals served each year, the Center also reaches out to the ever-increasing Hispanic community by providing information and referrals, transportation and immigration services.



Because of you and your generosity to the annual Appeal, over 16,000 students and their families are served through the Catholic School Office.

Your support of the Catholic Charity Fund Appeal helps 500 deaf and hard of hearing, 600 developmentally disabled and 300 blind individuals.



Your support will enable the Interfaith Community Dire Emergency Fund to continue to serve 7,200 clients annually by providing fuel, prescription, energy and rental assistance.

Your gift to the Catholic Charity Fund Appeal supports over 4,400 individuals who received assistance from Project Hope for immediate dire emergency needs, ESL, citizenship classes and other seasonal needs.
