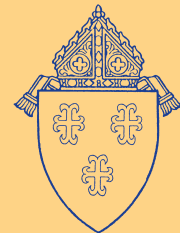

This apostolate coordinates activities of all services for the handicapped including service to the blind, deaf, and the physically handicapped.

Priest Immigration Ministries
